

Pineapple Quilteddie Walker 301-4545

Quilt sample is approx 70 x 70.

5 blocks x 5 blocks

Supplies needed for class.

Pineapple Ruler "PINEAPPLE TRIM TOOL" by Jean Ann Wright by Creative Grids.(please bring instruction that came with ruler. This is the larger one for 6, 8 and 10 inch block.

Sew Machine

Sewing Supplies.....thread, scissors, pins etc.

*Rotary Cutter....new blade

*Small Mat (18 x 22).....you will want a small mat at your work space.

Fabric.....fat quarter friendly or just lots of scraps.....or if you choose can be just 2 colors.*
This is a very scrappy quilt.....you will need approximately

25.....2 ½ inch squares for center of blocks

2 contrasting fabrics.....Approximately 3 yards of each cut into 2 inch strips.

This can be very scrappy of 2 colors.....total of approximately 6 yards.

7/8 yards ...For you final round you will need 100 rectangles that are 4 ½ x 2 ½ inches.....this will form the corners of you blocks and a secondary square in your quilt. You may want to choose one color or it can also be scrappy.

Before Class Cut:

25..... 2 ½ inch squares for your center of blocks

1004 ½ " x 2 ½ " rectangles for corners of each block.

*From Scarps or Color 1 Approximately 3 yards of strips cut in 2 inch strips (need to be at least 1 5/8 in)

From Scarps or Color 2 Approximately 3 yards of strips cut in 2 inch strips (need to be at least 1 5/8 in)

*Check out pineapple quilts online for images and setting I will bring several examples with me, it is amazing what this block can do. You may choose to use more colors

Color 1.....approx 3 yards of strips

Color 2.....approx 1 ½ yards of strips

Color 3.....approx 1 ½ yards of strips.
