Baby Quilts-4 quilts delivered so far in April. The guild got some nice feedback from one of the nurses; nice to have such a great selection of quilts for new moms to pick from.

Sounds like there may be a need to add a few cuddle quilts for stillborn babies. Bobbi has a supply of really soft, silky fabrics she will bring to the next sew day for this purpose. Andrea is looking into whether there is also a need for lap quilts for patients getting infusions. She will let us know.

We will be voting on baby quilts from Linda Knifong's fabrics next month, so get them finished up.

Raffle Quilt- is currently at the La Grande Quilt Shop. They have done a Facebook post featuring it.

Classes- open sew day on April 20th at VFW Hall, potluck lunch. Eddie Walker class has not been rescheduled. There will not be a sewing room tour and no other classes are planned.

Misc-medallion quilts are being voted on next month, so get them completed.
