Meeting was called to order at 6:00pm by President Marietta Herinckx. Twenty three members signed in. Minutes from the last meeting were approved.

Treasure's Report: Jeannie Alford provided a list of income and expenses from October 16th through January 9th just to keep us informed. To date, after income and expenses (and reserving \$500 for the barn quilt project) there is an available checking account balance of \$5,231.18. Some notable income was \$211 in raffle ticket sales at the oyster feed, and \$33 from raffle ticket sales at the senior meal site in Wallowa.
